<b>What is the overall <u>deductible</u>?</b>	<b>\$250</b> person/ <b>\$500</b> family per calendar year.	Generally, you must pay all the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
<b>Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u>?</b>	Yes. Well-child care, in- <u>network</u> <u>preventive care</u> , ambulance, in- <u>network</u> prosthetic limbs, in- <u>network</u> independent labs and services subject to health and drug card <u>copayments</u> are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . <b>What is the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> for this <u>plan</u>?</b>	Health: <b>\$750</b> person/ <b>\$750</b> family per calendar year. Drug Card: <b>\$750</b> person/ <b>\$750</b> family per calendar year. The In- <u>Network</u> health and drug card <u>out-of-pocket</u> maximum amounts accumulate together.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
<b>What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u>?</b>	Premiums, <u>balance-billed charges</u> , and health care this <u>plan</u> doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> .
