Monday, August 5, 2019

Mayor Steven K. Gaer opened the regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council of West Des Moines, Iowa, in the Council Chambers of the West Des Moines City Hall on Monday, August 5, 2019 at 5:30 PM. Council members present were: R. Hardman, J. Sandager, and R. Trimble.

Fire Chief Craig Leu introduced Fire Lieutenant Josh Schut, who was then sworn in by Mayor Gaer.

Council member Sandager reported the Bravo Greater Des Moines Board of Directors met and re-elected the same representatives to the executive committee, including himself as chair, to oversee the implementation of the strategic plan.

Council member Trimble reported he attended a meeting of the Finance and Administration Subcommittee, where discussion was held on a funding request from the West Des Moines Historical Society, a potential joint training facility for the West Des Moines Fire Department and the Iowa National Guard, a potential policy change regarding building permit fees, a property improvement fund project, and a request for changes to the Iowa Clinic development agreement.

Council member Hardman reported she attended a meeting of the Library Board of Trustees, where a report was given on library usage, and a joint meeting was also held with the West Des Moines Library Friends Foundation. She also reported the Development and Planning Subcommittee met and discussed the Historic West Des Moines Master Plan.

Council member Trimble inquired if staff is comfortable with the one-way access drive proposed for the east side of this development.

Brian Hemesath, City Engineer, responded staff was not comfortable with the east access drive being a right-in/right-out access, because the bridge would obscure the sight distance for vehicles exiting from that access drive. Staff offered three acceptable options to the developer, and they preferred this option with a one-way access drive for entering only.

Council member Trimble also expressed concerns about this development including private streets, which are often not constructed or maintained to city standards.

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Mayor Gaer noted staff is working on a policy regarding private streets.
