## COMPLEX RULES AND REGULATIONS

- OUTSIDE FOOD, BEVERAGES AND COOLERS ARE NOT ALLOWED INTO COMPLEX. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE COMPLEX. Please patronize and support YOUR concession stand.
- Only authorized motorized vehicles are allowed inside the Complex.
- Field is closed if gates to that field are locked or if "Field Closed" signs are present.
- Please use batting cages for hitting and bullpens for pitching warm ups. When warming up prior to games/practice, please play catch in the outfield. Do not disturb the batters boxes and chalk lines. Avoid warming up and positioning yourself in outfields where grass is worn, newly seeded or under repair. Do not warm up directly on outfield foul lines.
- Dogs are not allowed inside ballfield fences. Dogs are allowed in common areas between fields. All animals must always be under physical control by the owner by a leash not more than 10' in length. Owner must remove any droppings by the animal on the property.
- All litter shall be disposed of in trash receptacles.
- Pesticides, herbicides and other chemicals will be periodically applied to turf areas.
- Please refrain from throwing gum, candy, wrappers or sun flower seeds or any other trash onto playing field.
- Clean up all trash/litter in dugouts after every game or practice. Dispose of all trash in proper receptacles.
- Soft toss into fences is not allowed.
- For your safety, please sit/stand behind fenced area when any game is in progress.
- Only rostered players and coaches are allowed on the field or in the dugout during games/practices.
- Holiday Park Complex is a Tobacco Free facility.
- Tailgating in parking lots is a City Code violation.
- Vehicles must be parked in designated parking spaces only. RV or bus parking is not allowed in Holiday Park.
- No parking is allowed within designated drop off zones.
